## A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR TINA

### A Place at the Table

There is something sacred about being welcomed.  
Not just greeted at the door or handed a bulletin but truly being welcomed. Seen. Known. Received just as you are. In a world that can feel increasingly divided and hurried, the church has an opportunity to be something different. We are called to be family. And family, at its best, makes room at the table.

Throughout scripture, we see this image again and again; a table is set, a place is prepared, an invitation is extended. Jesus did not build His ministry around perfect people or polished lives.
