## MESSAGE FROM PASTOR KYLE

I am delighted to tell you all that I am now in the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship's Fellows Program. This program is designed to support new seminary graduates and early-career clergy during their "first-call" in congregational ministry. This means that I will walk with other new pastors in a cohort and we will journey together as we figure out what it means to be a pastor. We will not be doing this without any guidance as we will have mentors walking us through this whole program.

I am in a cohort with about 7 other pastors who are all new to ministry, just like I am. Nearly all of us are freshly out of seminary and all of us are within our first few years of ministry in our particular contexts. This group of women and men are going to be some of my close pastor partners and friends over the next approximately year and a half. Between the changes in the American culture, church culture, leadership changes, and differences just between our own perspectives, we will have a lot to talk about and support each other through.

I hope that this cohort and this group of pastors will be able to bring the next generations of pastors together and encourage each other through the rapidly changing culture and churches we find ourselves in. Our hope is that we are able to support each other and make Baptist life not so isolated.

While I am in this program, you can expect me to be out of the office a few times a year for different conferences, gatherings, and meetings as I am becoming more intertwined with CBF life and being a pastor within the scope of the CBF. I hope to be able to bring back and implement a lot of the things I learn here at Ball Camp. I pray that this will bring a brightness to my ministry here at Ball Camp and a joy to those around me.

I would not be able to be a CBF Fellow without y'all. So I want to say thank you for being you, being present, and encouraging me so far. I hope that y'all will keep praying for me as we do our readings, studies, and group sessions, and as I continue in my ministry here at Ball Camp. I am grateful for each and every one of you. I hope that you will continue to pray for me as I will be praying for each of you as well. May you find many blessings this week.
