MESSAGE FROM PASTOR TINA

Our worship today reminds us that church is about far more than attending worship once a week. In today's scripture, Paul paints a picture of Christian community that is rooted in love, humility, service, and grace.

"Love one another with mutual affection."
"Rejoice with those who rejoice; weep with those who weep."
"Live in harmony with one another."

These words remind us that being the church means choosing one another again and again.

In every church family, there will be differences. We come from different backgrounds, carry different experiences, and see the world through different lenses. At times, we may not fully agree with one another. Yet scripture does not call us to sameness. It calls us to love.

And perhaps that is one of the greatest witnesses the church can offer the world right now; a community that stays at the table together. A group of people who listen before speaking. A community that extends grace before judgment. People who remember that what unites us in Christ is greater than anything that could divide us.

Commitment to the church is not simply commitment to a building or a calendar. It is commitment to one another. Committed to praying together, serving together, grieving together, celebrating together, and walking together in faith.

In a world that often encourages people to walk away at the first sign of disagreement or difficulty, the church has an opportunity to model something different. We can become a community that chooses love over division, compassion over criticism, and relationship over convenience.

May we continue to choose one another with patience, grace, and love, trusting that God is still at work among us.
