MESSAGE FROM PASTOR LEE

In Romans 5, the Apostle Paul unpacks a radical truth about the nature of divine love. We often treat love as something to be earned, assuming we must fix our behavior before approaching God. Paul completely flips this human logic on its head.

"But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

Notice the timing of Christ's sacrifice. He did not wait for us to clean up our lives, say the right prayers, or reach spiritual perfection. The ultimate proof of God's love occurred at our absolute lowest point—while we were still actively broken, messy, and far from Him. Paul reminds us that God's love is a choice, not a reaction to our performance. He does not love an idealized, future version of us; He loves us in the middle of our current struggle. Because His love is rooted in His character rather than our perfection, we can never do anything to make Him love us more, and we can never fail enough to make Him love us less.

When you and I feel overwhelmed by guilt or inadequacy, remember that our security rests on Jesus' finished work, not our shifting emotions. Romans 5:5 assures us that this "love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit." It is an abundant, overflowing supply meant to remove our shame and give us unshakeable hope.

Live today knowing you are fully seen, deeply known, and completely loved by the One who created you.
