Morning Reading and Meditation	
Throughout the Gospels, Jesus asks questions. Some seem simple. Some are deeply personal. Some challenge assumptions. And some have a way of reaching beneath the answers we have learned to give to reveal what is really in our hearts.	
Jesus asks, "What are you looking for?" "Why are you afraid?" "What is your name?" "Do you want to be made well?" "What do you want me to do for you?" "Do you love me?"	
Jesus does not ask because he lacks the answers. He asks because sometimes a question can take us places an answer cannot.	
A question can interrupt the way we have always thought. It can uncover motives we have never examined. It can challenge assumptions we have carried for years. It can invite us to see God, ourselves, and our neighbors differently.	
As we begin this journey together, let us resist the temptation to answer too quickly.	
Let us listen. Let us wonder. Let us allow the questions of Jesus to linger long enough to become our questions.	
And as we worship, may we have the courage not simply to hear what Jesus asked long ago, but to consider what Jesus may be asking of us today.	
May we bring open minds, honest hearts, and willing spirits.
